

Some Guides For Doing The Quiz.

It can be daunting when you do a quiz for the first couple of times to follow the procedure... It's made even more daunting now we are doing it in isolation. Below is a brief run through of the format and course this quiz takes and it should help you enjoy it more. If at anytime you're unsure or don't hear a question fully then please don't hesitate to ask. All microphones are muted once the quiz starts so if you want to ask a question unmute your mic (Usually an Icon Shaped like a mic with a red line through... Touch that and it should unmute.

Don't forget to mute again after you have asked a question or everyone will be able to hear you.

1. Just before the quiz starts you will be informed what the **Bonus Round** question is. This round is worth 8 points and past examples are Name 8 Bond films with 1 word titles.

If you have downloaded the quiz answer sheet the **Bonus Round** is on the right hand side of the sheet. If you are using your own sheet please keep it separate from the other rounds.

2. Next is the **True or False round** this is as the name suggests 5 Questions where you have to tick if the statement is true or false. If you have downloaded the quiz sheet it is in the top right hand section of the sheet.

3. Next is **The Main Quiz** (Top Left Of The Quiz Sheet)
This Section consists of 34 Questions of which 4 Picture Questions generally worth 3 points each picture (Question Numbers 8, 16, 24 and 32) and example could be a photo of an actor and you will need to supply his name, character name and film title.

4. Question 20 is the **Music Round** This round is worth 8 points We play 4 samples of music and you can score **4 points** for the name of the artist or band
4 points for the **Correct** title of the track
Then question 21 is **What's the connection** for the 4 tracks previous examples have been.

Chris Rea – On The **Beach**

Buddy **Holly** – That'll Be The Day

The Who – Squeeze **Box**

Ed Sheeran – Shape Of **You**

The Connection = Beech, Holly, Box & Yew – Types Of Tree

Please note they don't have to be spelt the same it's just if the sound the same.

5. The final round is **The Numbers Round** this is just a guessing game really. The questions will be things you are not really supposed to know... How many metres long is Loch Ness, How many floors has the empire state building etc. when you have guesstimated your 5 answers add them together and the total nearest to the correct answer wins..
